Compensation Input Form Change Discussion

Showing Service Contract Update

Staff has received a first draft of the ShowingTime contract. In consultation with President Anne Burroughs we have not finalized the agreement until we can learn more from Bright MLS to confirm that ShowingTime will be a part of the new Bright MLS Showing Hub. Staff was asked to negotiate a contingency clause in the ShowingTime contract that would allow us to cancel the contract if ShowingTime was not a Bright MLS Showing Hub vendor.

Sentrilock Reciprocity Agreements

Staff indicated that many of our surrounding associations using Sentrilock have requested reciprocity agreements. The Committee requested Staff inquire with those associations would consider a datashare so that all agents are aware of showing instructions and can have access to agent notes before using the Sentrilock lockbox on a property.

Regional Data Share

Staff explained that Core Logic has a product called Trestle that will allow Staff to manage our MLS data feeds. Additionally, Core Logic has a product called Trestle Share that will allow us to more simply participate in a Virginia Regional Data Share. Staff was asked to continue discussions with the other Virginia MLSs to move towards understanding more final logistics and financial commitments for the Virginia Regional Data Share.
